PSL – Zone and Club Participation Rules

PSL - Zone and Club Participation Rules

The intent of these rules is to govern teams of the RSA enabling participation in the PSL.

1. Any player movement **MUST** be done through the Zoning Placement Committee and the existing placement processes.
2. Where no PSL team exists in a zone, a player must be released from their zone in accordance with our rules and apply with the Zoning Placement Committee. If not directly released, the player's contested release will also go directly to the Zoning Placement Committee. Any release granted for PSL purposes, is **ONLY** for PSL purposes.
3. If a zone has a PSL team in that age division, age eligible players will not be allowed to transfer out-of-zone for PSL play. Zones are encouraged to maintain the integrity of the zone and the remainder of their programs.
4. Players cannot transfer to a higher age division outside of their designated zone if there is a team they are age eligible to play for in their zone.
5. If there is no PSL team within the players grandfathered zone, grandfathering privileges will be maintained while playing on a PSL team.
6. Any cross zone formation of teams to participate in the PSL must have the approval of the RSA Board of directors in advance of any team registration and must demonstrate and have agreement on a fair and equitable selection process.

Please note that in the announcement letters from the Saskatchewan Soccer Association, it was indicated and intended that each district is to follow their own zoning/placement guidelines.
